Rifle Club Shooting Match Instructions

Revised 04/13/2014 (Carson City Rifle & Pistol Club gun shooting instructions.docx)

High Power Rifle (shooting fee \$10.00)

1st Saturday of the month, *Vintage Rifle after High Power Match*

Course of fire- Standing, Sitting and Prone at 100 yards. 50 shots for record

Rapid fire shot in position

Standing -- 2 sighters, then 10 shots for record -- 12 mins

Mandatory magazine change

Rapid Sitting - 2 sighters in 2 minutes, then 2 five shot or 2&8 shot mags. - 10 shots for record ---60 secs.

Rapid Prone - 2 sighters in 2 minutes, then 2 five shot or 2&8 shot mags. - 10 shots for record --- 70 secs.

Slow Prone - 2 Sighters, then 20 shots for record -- 22 mins.

Four Classes

Service Rifle, (i.e.) AR-15, M1, M14

Match Rifle

Open - any sights with rest

Vintage Rifle- WWII design or earlier (same round count)

8 days after 1st Saturday of the Month

Mini Palma 22 rim fire rifle (shooting fee \$10.00)

Course of Fire- Prone at 100 yards, 45 shots for record

15 shots on each of three targets- 800, 900 & 1000 yards reduced

800 -- Unlimited sighters then -- 15 shots for record- 20 minutes

900 -- 2 sighters then -- 15 shots for record -17 minutes

1000 -- 2 sighters then -- 15 shots for record- 17 minutes

Three Classes

IRON - sight with sling

SCOPE - sight with sling

OPEN - any sights with rest

(After Mini Palma, move to pistol range)

Bullseye Pistol - Rim fire or Center fire. Iron or optical sights (shooting fee \$5.00)

Course of Fire- Standing @ 25 yards, no sighters, 30 shots for record

NATIONAL MATCH COURSE (30 shots)

10 shots slow fire-- Time 10 minutes on B16 target

10 shots timed fire - Time 20 seconds for each of two five shot strings on B8 target

10 shots rapid fire-- Time 10 seconds for each of two five shot strings on B8 target
